BUS SHELTER

The shelter on The Village in St Keyne is maintained and cleaned by the parish council.



GRANTS & DONATIONS

We run a small grants and donations scheme to fund local organisations whose work we support. Full T&Cs on the website.



GROUND MAINTENANCE & FOOTPATHS

We maintain footpaths and open spaces in the parish by grass cutting, strimming and weed spraying throughout the year.



OPEN SPACES & PLAYGROUND

We own Jubilee Park located near Valley View in St Keyne and maintain and safety-check the children's play equipment there.



PLANNING

We act as consultees for all planning applications made within the parish boundary and are involved in other planning matters in any area that adjoins us. Details of all applications are included on the council's monthly agenda. If you have any comments to make on applications, please email us.



LAWN CEMETERY

The parish council owns and manages the lawn cemetery adjacent to the churchyard in St Keyne. Residents (and people with links to the parish) benefit from reduced fees. See our website for more information.
