12	Speeding vehicles – pedestrian safety	Unsafe driving of cars and vans through Trewidland centre.	Parish council supports the '20's Plenty' speed campaign and will be lobbying Cornwall Council to include Trewidland in its proposals to create 20mph areas in villages. This will be discussed by Cornwall Council's Economic Growth and Development Overview and Scrutiny Committee on 5 October. The parish council will include this on its agenda for the 13 October meeting.	Parish Clerk
13	Speeding vehicles – horse riders	Vehicles travelling at speed are not passing 'wide and slow' around horses.	See item 12 above	Parish Clerk
14	Horses riders using public roads	Horse riders not using narrow roads safely when sharing space with vehicles	A Trewidland councillor will speak with the owners of the local riding school to obtain clarity on best practice.	Chair
15	Salt bins	At least two of the salt storage bins appear to be damaged.	These bins are owned by the parish council and will be replaced before the winter season.	Parish Clerk

16	Blocked drain near Trehere	The ditch in this vicinity becomes blocked with debris causing water to run over the road that freezes in the winter, causing a road safety hazard,	Following up the exact location with the complainant to report the matter to Cormac.	Parish Clerk
17	Pop-up camping site	Rules around what is permitted in a temporary camping site have recently been relaxed. This complaint is about the limits to those rules that appear to have been breached.	Parish Council Chair Sally Lewis has replied to the resident's complaint and is taking advice from Cornwall Council Planning and the ward councillor.	Cllrs Sally Lewis and Armand Toms.
