20mph Speed Reduction Consultation

1.0 Background

1.1 Cornwall Council is preparing for a public consultation on proposals to reduce the local speed limit from 30mph to 20mph. This is part of a wider roll-out across the county. Camelford and Falmouth and Penryn have already had their local limits reduced. You can read about the results on the CC website: <https://tinyurl.com/3z86s75w>. This site also includes a detailed FAQs section that explains the background to the project.

1.2 CC will be conducting a public consultation between 27 November and 20 December 2024, and is asking for parish councils to support it. Historically, we know that speeding in the roads around Trewidland is a regular source of complaint from residents. At your public meeting on 13 November 2024, the Chair will be asking for volunteers to proactively engage with our residents to get their views.

2.0 What areas are for consultation?

2.1 At the pre-consultation stakeholder event that was held on 2 September, one area in the parish was identified as potential 20mph area: the map attached shows where the area could be.

3.0 Resources

3.1 The council has a public noticeboard at Trewidland, so we can use these to display a large format map of their locality, together with contact details where they can feed back to CC. Our social media account on Facebook can be used to promote the consultation and raise awareness of the potential impact the change may have in their area. Councillors may wish to consider reaching out to affected community groups to encourage them to take part in the consultation.

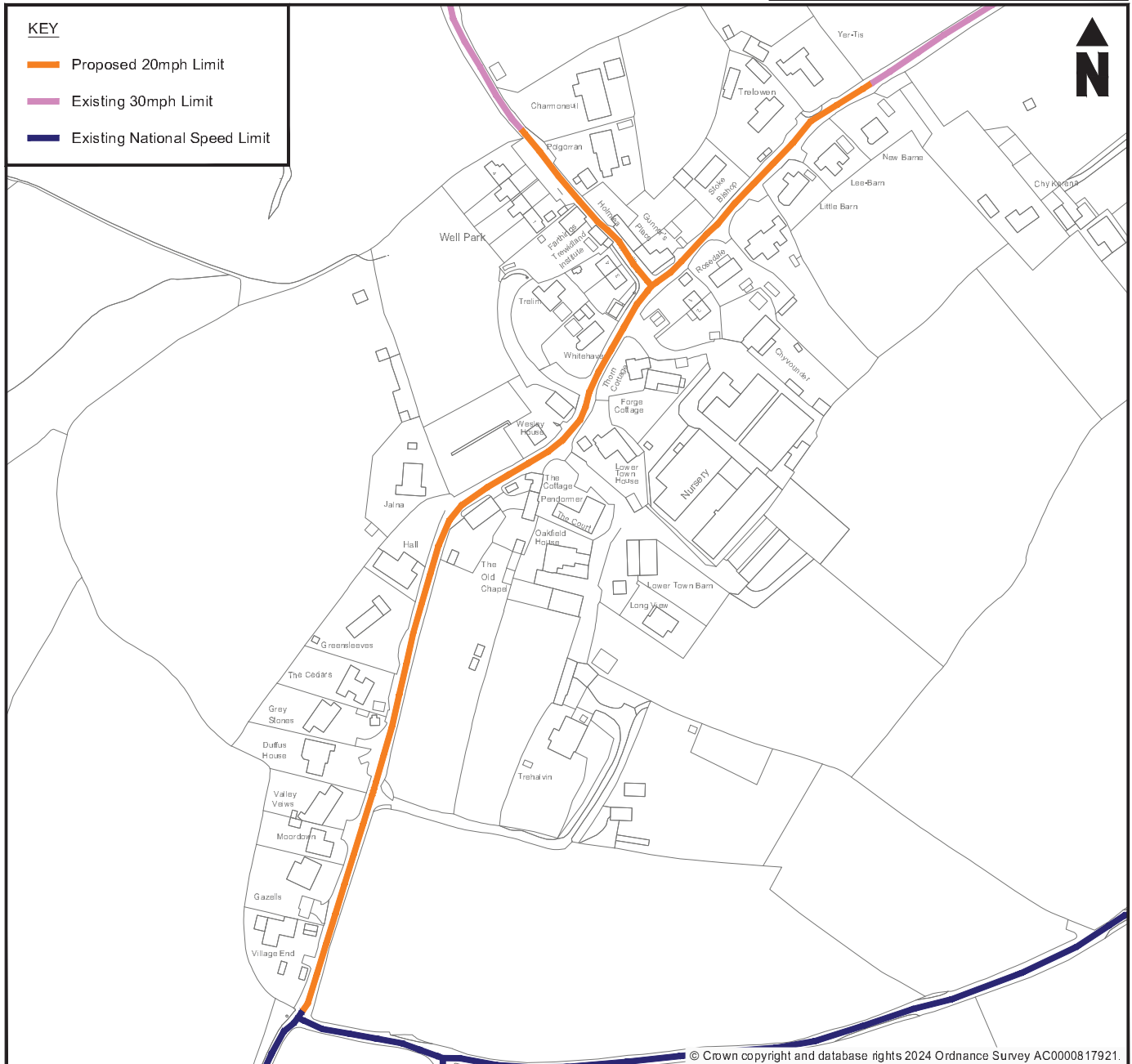
